FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - JOHN -:

“When the wine ran short, the mother of Jesus said to him, ‘They have no wine.’ [And] Jesus said to her: ‘Woman, how does your concern affect me? My hour has not yet come.’ His mother said to the servers, ‘Do whatever he tells you.’” (John 2:3-5)¹

MEDITATION ON THE MYSTERY:

If we listen to Mary – that is, to Our Lady and to the Church – who tells us in the right way, “*Do whatever He tells you*” (cf. *John 2:5*), we (in Christ) will be able to save many souls: or rather, Christ as the Head of His Body which is the Church (cf. *Col 1:18*) will be able to save many souls through his Mystical Body (cf. *Col 1:24*), as it is written, “*by doing so you will save both yourself and those who listen to you*” (*1Tim 4:16*).
