“The Wedding of Cana”...

FROM THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO - JOHN -:

“There was a wedding in Cana in Galilee....When the wine ran short, the mother of Jesus said to him, ‘They have no wine.’ [And] Jesus said to her: ‘Woman, how does your concern affect me? My hour has not yet come.’ His mother said to the servers, ‘Do whatever he tells you.’” (John 2:1-5)¹

MEDITATION ON THE MYSTERY:

Jesus, at Mary’s request, changed the water of the 6 jars into true wine, a figure of the Divine Spirit which transforms our human maturity into the full maturity of Christ (cf. Eph 4:13) so that we can espouse, well and with joy, the right way of Christian life. (cf. SLC, p. 206G)

FROM THE TEACHINGS OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH:

- In regards to espousing the right way of Christian life, the Lord told St. Catherine of Siena in a vision: *“Since for my love you have thrown away all vain things and fled from them, ...as I promised you, I will espouse you to me in faith.”* (VITTORIO PERI [ed.], *Caterina da Siena*, Velar, p. 15 [unpublished translation by pfgsm])
